### Tax credit vs. Tax deduction ~

A **tax deduction** reduces the amount of total income on which taxes are based.

A **tax credit** is used to reduce total tax liability.

**Generally, a tax credit is worth substantially more than a tax deduction.**



## Neighborhood

### Investment Program (NIP)

Businesses and individuals who contribute to NIP organizations are eligible to receive up to 50% of the contributed amount in the form of **WV state tax credits**. Donors may use the credits to reduce liability for the following WV taxes:

- **Corporate Net Income Tax**
- **Business Franchise Tax**
- **Personal Income Tax**

UGWA is approved to distribute tax vouchers to donors. The minimum eligible donation is \$500.
