Upper Guyandotte Watershed Receives Funding From Mountain RC & D Council

On behalf of the UGWA, Dewey Houck accepted a check for \$1,000 from the Mountain RC & D Council. The Council along with other agencies have partnered with the UGWA to do a study to determine what action is needed to improve stream water in the Guyandotte watershed. As information the Mountain Resource Conservation & Development Council is made up of representatives from twelve Southern West Virginia Counties and is supported by USDA. In addition to the Watershed Association project the Council has adopted the Coal Heritage Byway Green Space & Trailhead project. Dewey Houck and Harold Hayden are board members of the RC & D Council.
