Upper Guyandotte Watershed Association Received Grant

The Upper Guyandotte Watershed Association recently received a grant from the WV Stream Partners program. The grant will be used to help support ongoing UGWA projects such as the annual appliance and scrap metal collection at the MOC, Make It Shine stream cleanup, development of the wastewater treatment plan, and trout stocking conducted in partnership with the Upper Guyandotte Chapter Trout Unlimited.

UGWA appreciated the support of Stream Partners. Programs such as this are vital to the success of UGWA efforts to improve water qual-

ity in local rivers and streams.

The Stream Partners program is a cooperative effort of the following WV state agencies: Division of Forestry, Conservation Agency, Department of Environmental Protection, and Division of Natural Resources. The purpose of the Stream Partners program is to "support community groups that are dedicated to assuring that their local rivers and streams are safe for swimming, fishing, recreation, public and commercial purposes, and provide habitat for plant and animal life."
